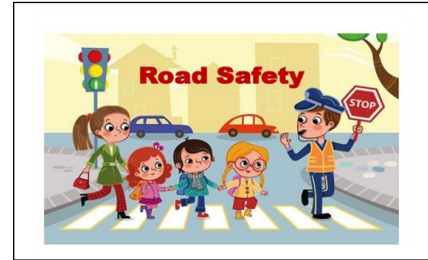

2. Fruits and vegetables

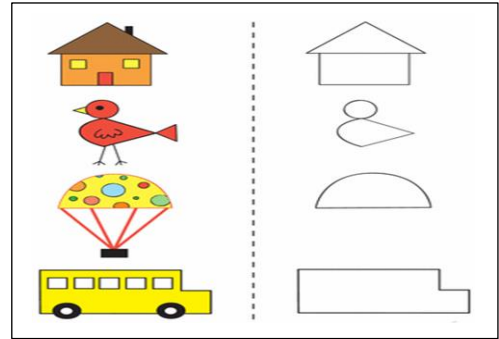
Fruits are yummy,

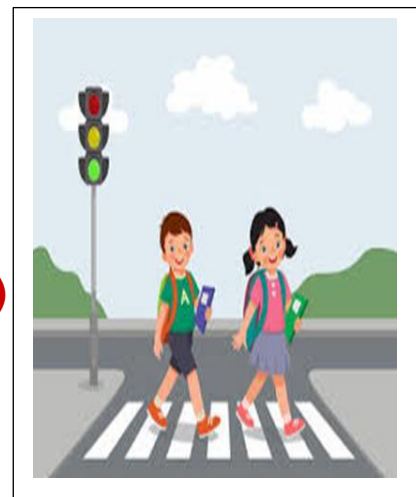

Ans. Cow gives us milk.



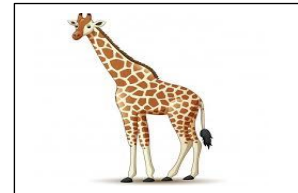

Ans. DOG guards our house.



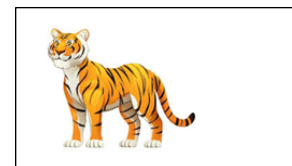
